The nature of Lake Towada and Mt. Hakkoda throughout the four seasons is also particularly beautiful.


If you want to see traditional culture and original scenery, come to Akita.

Yamagata If you like skiing, hot springs, and Japanese beef, come to Yamagata.






What is Miyagi Prefecture like?





300 km northeast of Tokyo, in the center of the Tohoku Region. There are many places to visit, such as Sendai, where the Samurai warrior Date Masamune ruled, good fishing grounds on the Sanriku Coast, and Matsushima, one of the three best scenic spots in Japan. Mt. Zao is also visited by many tourists who enjoy Juhyo, the frost-covered trees, and skiing. Sendai is the gateway to the Tohoku Region, connected to Tokyo by the Tohoku Shinkansen in just 1.5 hours approximately, as well as Sendai Airport, with regular domestic and international flights.


